Omnicanne Thermal Energy Operations operates a 90 MW thermal power plant at La Baraque – L'Escalier for the production of steam and electricity. During crop season, bagasse is the main source of energy while coal is used during off-crop season. Part of the steam and electricity generated is used by the adjacent sugar cluster, while the main part of the electricity produced is exported onto the national grid.
