- Improve mechanical harvesting efficiency

Environmental Sustainability:

The Company is also committed to minimise its environmental risks and manage the environmental impacts of its operations and activities in line with Principle 1 and Principle 4 of the Bonsucro Production Standard and the Group Environmental Policy through the following objectives:

- Comply with all relevant environmental laws and standards
- Implement pollution prevention programmes
- Optimise use of water and energy resources for agricultural activities including irrigation for the benefit of its operations and neighbouring community
- Implement strategies to reduce, reuse and recycling of wastes wherever possible

- Take actions to reduce the carbon footprint of its operations wherever possible
- Protect biodiversity, ecosystem services, High Conservation Value (HCV) areas in case they fall within the immediate vicinity of its operational sites
