Omnicanne Ethanol Production Limited operates a bio-ethanol distillery at La Baraque and a bio-ethanol storage facility in the Port Area. The main purpose of Omnicane Ethanol Production Limited is to produce high quality neutral bio-ethanol using molasses. The two by-products from the manufacturing process are carbon dioxide and Concentrated Molasses Stillage. The carbon dioxide is captured and further processed by Gaz Carbonique for application in the beverage industry, while the Concentrated Molasses Stillage is used by Island Renewable Fertilizer (IRF) as Bio-fertilizer. Both Gaz Carbonique and IRF are independent and distinct entities from Omnicane Ethanol Production Limited.
